Agency Certification

- Any agency or organization interested in submitting an application for funding must be certified. Certification documentation must be submitted to UWFC annually by the first business day in November (2018: 11/1)
- The certification process and deadline pertains to both currently funded partners as well as potential partners
- Organizations will be notified by November 16th if UWFC certification requirements were met and open the application process to all approved organizations

Agency Certification

Partner Agency Standards Certification Form:

- Section 1: to be completed by all agencies, regardless of whether or not they are currently funded by the United Way of Fairfield County
- Section 2: to be completed by agencies requesting funds for a new program that is not currently funded by UWFC

Please be aware that the filing system may experience slowdowns during peak hours.

Ohio requires charitable organizations located in Ohio and groups that ask Ohioans for contributions to file annual reports with the Attorney General's Office. These filings are public and contribute to accountability and transparency within the charitable sector.

Groups are required to use the online system to fulfill their duties under the Charitable Trust Act (RC 109.23) and the Charitable Solicitations Act (R.C. 1716.02). Multiple individuals from each organization are encouraged to create accounts in order to receive reminders on filing deadlines, confirmation of filings, and other important information.

File Online

Use of the online system is mandatory for all charitable organizations. The online system replaces all previous forms used for filings under R.C. 109 or R.C. 1716, which include the Verification of Filing with the Internal Revenue Service, Charitable Organization Registration Statement, AG Financial, Unified Registration Statement and any IRS tax forms such as the 990, 990-PF, etc.

The public can not search our database or information on whether groups are in compliance with Ohio's registration laws and get basic information on registered
